Format: Will be determined by the number of entrants.

- 1. In the doubles competition pairs will be formed from two individuals without respect to gender.
- 2. The age of the doubles team is determined by the age of younger player.
- 3. The usual four-disk practice will be used prior to each game.
- 4. You will be expected to provide your own cue.
- 5. Singles matches will consist of two games of ten frames each; if each player wins one game, they will play two additional frames to break the tie.
- 6. Two matches will be played on one court at the same time. Opposing players will play from the same end of the court. Players will not change ends after any frame.
- 7. Doubles matches will consist of two games of ten frames each. Partners will play from opposite ends of the court. Each partner will complete ten frames. Players will not switch ends at any time after the start of the match. In case of a tie, all four players will receive an additional hammer. This procedure will continue until the tie is broken.
- 8. The cue shall not have an overall length of more than six foot, three inches. No metal part of the cue shall touch the playing surface.
- 9. The Event Director reserves the right to modify the format based on the number of entrants.
- 10. All shuffleboard matches will be conducted in accordance with National Shuffleboard Association (NSA) rules, except as modified herein. For a copy of these rules, please contact:
